Notice is hereby given pursuant to TCA 2-12-111(a) that a State Primary and County General will be held on Thursday August 1, 2024.

State Primary Election for:

United States Senator, United States House of Representatives District 3, Tennessee Senate District 2, Tennessee House of Representatives District 22

The first day a nominating petition may be issued is **Monday, February 5, 2024**. Qualifying deadline will be **Thursday, April 4, 2024 at 12:00 noon**. The withdrawal deadline, will be **Thursday, April 11, 2024 at 12:00 NOON**.

County General Election:

District Attorney General (unexpired term), County Commission District 4 (unexpired term), Assessor of Property, Road Superintendent, Constables, School Board and Fourth Fractional Township.

The first day a nominating petition for Fourth Fractional Township Candidates may be issued is **Monday, February 5, 2024**.

Qualifying deadline will be **Thursday, April 4, 2024 at 12:00**.

The withdrawal deadline will be **Thursday, April 11, 2024 at 12:00 NOON**.

First day to receive requests for by-mail ballots **Friday, May 3, 2024**.

Deadline for receiving an application for a by-mail ballot **Thursday, July 25, 2024**.

The last day to register to vote in person or by mail postmark for the August 6, 2020 Election will be **Tuesday, July 2, 2024**.

Public Notice for Elderly Voters or Voters with Disabilities

Any elderly voter or voter with a disability whose polling place is inaccessible may vote early by absentee ballot or at the Election Commission Office on Election Day.

TCA 2-3-109 (e) (1). If the voter chooses to vote at the Election Commission on Election Day, they must complete an affidavit at the Election Commission Office **no later than Monday, July 22, 2024** stating that their designated voting location is not accessible. PHOTO ID REQUIRMENTS FOR ALL VOTERS.

All voters must present a Photo ID. The ID must be issued by the Federal or State of Tennessee Government and contain the voter's name and photograph.
